The driver's Frontal Head Restraint (FHR) was not correctly positioned before leaving

the working area.

Offence:

Breach of Article 33.13 of the GT Challenge Europe Sporting Regulations

Decision:

Stop-and-go penalty converted to 35 seconds added to the elapsed race time of

car 4 and 1 Behaviour Warning Point to the driver

Reason:

The driver's FHR was not correctly positioned before leaving the working area, and the driver continued to make adjustments to the positioning of his belts in relation to the FHR during his out lap as far as turn 10. Having summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, and having viewed video evidence from the driver-facing camera, the Stewards determine that this is a breach of the above regulation and consider this to be a serious safety matter. Accordingly, they impose the penalty above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
